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Lift of Ambulette Enrollment Moratorium

Under current Medicaid guidelines, potential Medicaid ambulette providers are denied enrollment in the Medicaid program when the proposed service will operate in New York City, and/or Nassau and/or Suffolk County as it has been determined by the New York State Department of Health that these locations have an adequate number of existing ambulette providers.

The moratorium on ambulette provider applications to provide ambulette services in New York City, Nassau and Suffolk Counties will be lifted effective **December 1, 2021**. This supersedes the previous guidance and allows ambulette companies to enroll in Category of Service 0602 across all counties (contingent on the provider meeting other enrollment criteria).

Previously denied applications received prior to December 1, 2021 will not be automatically processed. However, ambulette providers that submitted applications for these service areas prior to December 1, 2021 may now reapply.
